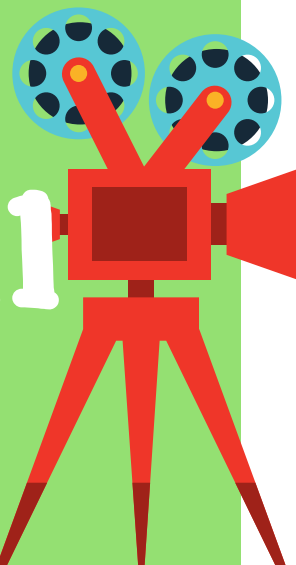

“On-Camera” Camp - is an introduction to television that gives students the unique opportunity to work on scenes, improvisation and audition sides from commercials, television and monologues. Each student will be exploring, developing and performing commercials and monologues through scripts and improvisation. The camp focuses on the different acting techniques needed to excel in that particular art form.

Each student will be performing a skit from each category and developing their writing and acting skills to a deeper level of understanding as they learn how to incorporate the different styles of acting. Students can choose a subject matter to focus on and also work on set assignments. We will also explore alternative techniques like printmaking, tempera batik, collage and fiber art. Limited to 15 students

Change the fate of the world we create as you and your party travel through the land facing obstacles, taking on quests, fighting beasts and solving mysteries.
